### Guest Information

Situated on the shore of Keuka Lake, the Yates County Arts Center at Sunny Point offers beautiful grounds, spacious barn studio and a charming cottage providing a haven for inspiration and learning. The red studio barn has a large well-lit main space, screened porch, two additional work spaces, bathroom and kitchen.

The furnished white cottage has three bedrooms. One bedroom has 2 twin beds, the remaining bedrooms each have a pull-out, detachable trundle bed (2 twin mattresses). There is a shower, a spacious living/dining area overlooking the lake, fully operational kitchen, and a screened in porch.

**Artistic Retreat Season:** June 15 to October 15, 2016 Weekly residencies run from Sunday to Saturday. Subject to availability.

**Reservation Fee:** Artistic Retreat fee for 3 day stay \$750; 5 day stay \$1,200; 7 day stay \$1,500. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due with registration. Balance due one week prior. Payable to ACYC.

**Check-In/Out:** Please check in Sunday after 1:00 PM and check-out Saturday by 11:00 AM

**Cleaning:** The white cottage and red barn are cleaned and inspected prior to your arrival. All guests are responsible for cleaning both buildings before checking out, so that its original condition is restored. Guests are responsible for any major or intentional damage. Please leave all used bed linens and towels in the basket provided in the white cottage.

**Pets:** No pets are permitted.

**Occupancy Limits:** The MAXIMUM number of allowable occupants is eight. Please do not bring campers, tents or motor homes.

**Smoking:** Smoking is prohibited inside the white cottage and red barn. If you do smoke, you are responsible for the proper removal of any smoking debris.

**What to bring:**

- Residency artist and students are expected to bring their own tools, supplies and materials
- Firewood for outdoor fire pit
- Charcoal for grill
- Beach towels, water toys
- Fishing gear
- Kayak, canoe, rowboat, bicycles

**What is available in white cottage:**

- Bed linens, bath towels, wash cloths, blankets/comforters, mattress pads, kitchen linens
- Cutlery, place settings, cups and glasses
- Microwave
- Coffee maker, mixing bowls, pots and pans
- CD player/radio, TV
- Outdoor grill
- Fans

**What is available in red barn:**

- Hand towels
- 4-6 six foot tables
- 12 folding chairs
- Coffee maker
- Fans
- Stackable washer and dryer
